## PPGL SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

Scholarships will be awarded in accordance with their respective Public Notices. They aim to promote research and are conditioned to Program quota availability, per the Scholarship Commission's evaluation, according to determined criteria divulged via public notices by the Course Board, in compliance with the following hierarchy:

- A) Curriculum lattes
- B) School Transcript (Permanent Record)

The Scholarship Commission, according to Capes norms and other funding agencies, comprises the Program Coordinator, a teaching representative elected by the Program Board, and a student representative, elected by the student body.

The Scholarship Committee is responsible for periodically evaluating the performance of scholarship holders. If it finds the scholarship holder's performance in the disciplines and activities of the Program unsatisfactory, it may request his/her disaccreditation. The scholarship will be transferred to the next student on the ranking list released by the Scholarship Commission and by the Program Department.

The scholarship holder must provide proof of the following:

I - presence in three annual defenses and in events promoted by the Program (conferences, round tables, symposia, work groups, seminars and other academic activities, convened by the course coordination);

II - participation in two academic-scientific events with presentation of a work and publication in proceedings, and/or publication of 1 article in an ISSN-registered journal with an Editorial Board;

III - participation in the organizing committee of events promoted by the Program;

IV - submission of an academic-scientific report to the Program's department, containing the advisor's opinion and signature, when requested by the Program's coordination.

Failure to meet these minimal participatory requirements implies that the scholarship will be transferred to the next student on the ranking list released by the Scholarship Commission and by the Program Department.

All academic works produced and published during the Scholarship Period must include a footnote with information on the received financial support and funding agency.
