Dissertation Seminar	After obtaining credits in elective and mandatory subjects.	By the 3rd semester.
Teaching Internship	30 hours in one semester.	By the 3rd semester.
Special activities I and II	I: participation in an institutionalized extension activity, promoted or accepted by the Program. II: Presentation and publication of a complete paper in the proceedings of a national or international congress in the Program area.	By the qualification-exam request.
Proficiency	One language: English, Spanish, French, Italian or German.	By the qualification-exam request.
Qualification	After obtaining credits in elective, compulsory subjects, special activities I and II, teaching internship, dissertation seminar and passing the proficiency exam.	By the beginning of the 4th semester. The application must be submitted 45 days before the scheduled exam date, with an informal

		history and copies of the application for all members of the board.
Special Activity III	III: Publication or letter of acceptance of 1 paper in a journal in the Program area with an Editorial Board, ISSN registration, and Qualis classification.	By the defense-request date.
Defense	Application containing the advisor's opinion, accompanied by an informal history	24 months from the date of enrollment (extendable by 6 months with justification from the supervisor).
